### Registration:

Register Online now at [www.dayofthetread.org](http://www.dayofthetread.org) for early bird registration discounts. Fees will go up September 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 and late registration begins October 7, 2017. Fees vary depending on the route.

Packet Pick Up will be October 26<sup>th</sup> at the Albuquerque Convention Center from 10 am -4 pm and prior to the ride on October 27<sup>th</sup>. It is highly recommended that you pick up your packet on Saturday before race day.

Safety rules and route maps will be available at Packet Pick-up. Volunteer riders will be available to answer questions related to the routes, major intersections, rules of the road etc. Helmets are mandatory for all participants. The course is not a closed course so all NEW MEXICO Bicycle laws are mandatory. The Olev Rapido Cycling Team will be acting as Ride Marshalls for the courses. They will be strictly and professionally monitoring all participants to ensure that all rules of the road are maintained. They are designated by the wearing of Ride Marshall Bib and a very distinctive green kit. In addition they will be acting as ambassadors providing route guidance and will support riders who have minor technical issues including flats. Moving SAG support will also be available throughout the course and Technicians from various Albuquerque Bike Shops will be providing stationary support at selected Recharge Zones.
